Patient Participation Group Botesdale Health Centre Question of the Month

Q: What is an Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP) and what can they do?

A: ANPs are qualified to carry out many tasks that patients may previously have associated only with GPs. Their extended scope of practice typically includes:

- Providing advanced nursing care for a wide range of conditions
- Taking a full patient history
- Carrying out clinical assessments and physical examinations
- Ordering and interpreting diagnostic tests
- Diagnosing illnesses and conditions
- Prescribing medications (as independent prescribers)
- Offering treatment, advice, and ongoing management
- Making referrals to hospital specialists or other healthcare professionals.

These responsibilities are supported by national frameworks and professional standards. Although they work independently, they regularly liaise with GPs and the rest of the primary care team to make sure patients get the best possible care.
