

**HINDERCLAY PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN THE VILLAGE HALL ON  
THURSDAY 25<sup>th</sup> November 2018**

1. Apologies – None.
2. Declaration of Interest on any item - Nothing declared.
3. Planning Applications –
  - i. Plough Farm, Hinderclay – The planning application was discussed and all the plans were reviewed. The Parish Councillors all voted in favour of the application but asked the clerk to query access for the new property as the entrance was on a blind corner.
  - ii. Fir Tree Cottage, Hinderclay – The planning application was discussed and plans were looked at by the Parish Council. All councillors voted in favour of the extension.
4. Burglaries - The chair of the Parish Council wished to bring this item to the villages attention. A few thefts have occurred in the village from cars and sheds and people have been caught on CCTV in the early hours of the morning looking closely at houses. There are a group of Romanians renting a property in the village, they are employed by Suffolk Mushrooms and one member from the group has recently been asked to leave as he was seen as a trouble maker. PC Stefan Henriksen is going to attend the next PC meeting to talk to residents about the matter.
5. Village Hall exterior wall – Some of the exterior walls of the village hall have damaged concrete beams which are in urgent need of repair. The Parish Council have been made aware of the problem and the shortfall the Village Hall Committee face after donations from SCC and Mid Suffolk DC and have offered support. They await the full builders report.
