# Hinderclay celebrations for HM Queen's Platinum Jubilee


If you would like to be involved in these celebrations, please come along to a

#### The Parish Council

The Council met to debate some outstanding matters.

The first was the future of the Village Green. It was agreed that the Green is an important asset and must be maintained to a high standard and enhanced in ways which will both improve its appearance and make it useful to villagers. It was decided to produce a specification for work to deal with the damage caused by heavy vehicles.

The second item was footpaths. After debate it was resolved to ask the Clerk to invite a member of the Area Team at Suffolk County Council, which is responsible for public rights of way, to come to a meeting to discuss how the both Councils might work together. It was also decided that, should the meeting take place, it would be open to members of the village.


The third item was the Meeting of the Parish Council on 9th September. Members confirmed that the meeting will include an extended period for public participation and will include the presentation of finance and the powers of Parish Councils. Inhabitants of the village will be invited to make suggestions concerning the Council's role in matters affecting the future of Hinderclay. Light refreshments will be provided. Please make every effort both to attend and participate!

The Council also decided to be actively involved in the Queen' Platinum Jubilee next year. As a start, Councillors will attend the public meeting to be held in the Village Hall on 22<sup>nd</sup> September.

Policy for public use of Parish Council land (e.g. Village Green) The Parish Council will require all persons, or organisations, wishing to use land owned by the Parish Council for events, or advertisements, to seek permission at least six weeks prior to proposed use. This permission must be sought in writing, detailing desired use and accompanied by a full Risk Assessment. The request will then be considered by the Parish Council at the next available opportunity to ensure that it aligns with their legal responsibilities and insurance cover. The Parish Council decision is final.
