


### St. Mary's Church Services for May

## GREEN HINDERCLAY



Thanks to all who attended our onsite meeting behind the Village Hall recently. It was agreed that for the most part we will survey the site this year to see what we do have living there. Just a few wild flowers will be planted and we are also going to build a beetle log pile.

So far we have a count of 60 cowslips on the site. Also recorded to date ; Brimstone and Peacock butterfly, Dark-edged bee-fly and White and Buff-tailed Bumblebee. On the playing field we have located 10 bee orchid plants and these have been enclosed to protect them.

Do you have swifts nesting under your eaves? We are conducting a swift survey this year in Hinderclay, Redgrave, Hopton, Thelnetham and Blo Norton. Swifts should start returning any time from the last week in April, with most birds arriving in the first 2 weeks of May.
