

## Green Hinderclay

Green Hinderclay has continued to monitor and record flora and fauna within the parish during June. On Thursday 15th June, several members from Hinderclay and Redgrave went on a very informative farm visit to Barkers at Westhorpe. We learned about the farms cropping regime and how it ties in with no ploughing and minimal use of sprays. Wildlife is plentiful on the farm, which still has

breeding Turtle Doves, plus large numbers of Linnets and Yellowhammers. The farm featured on the recent Sir David Attenborough series, Saving Our Wild Isles, episode 6. This is available on iPlayer.

The Bee Orchids have flowered in the playing field and we will be collecting seed very soon. Do come and have a look in the area behind the village hall, it is currently a blaze with the Yellow Common Birds Foot Trefoil. There is also Yellow Rattle, Oxeye Daisy and much more in flower. Spare a moment to look skywards and you might be lucky enough to spot a Kestrel or Red Kite (frequently seen). We don't have any dates booked in for activities during the summer. Enjoy your holidays and we will have some announcements in the Autumn.
