Hinderclay Coffee Morning


The next coffee mornings will be held on **Thurs**day 14th December and Thursday 11th Jan**uary** at Hinderclay Village Hall from 10.30am

From Monday 8th January2024, collections will return to the normal garden waste collection schedule.

Are you aware of Prescription saving schemes?

A Prescription Prepayment Certificate will save Patients money if they pay for more than three items in three months, or 11 items in 12 months.

The Certificate covers all NHS prescriptions for a set pre-paid price, which can also be spread over 10 direct debit payments.

Patients on a low income could be entitled to help with costs or free prescriptions through the low-income scheme, depending on their circumstances. Patients can check if they're eligible for free prescriptions at www.nhsbsa.nhs.uk/check or find out more about the Prescription Prepayment Certificates at www.nhsbsa.nhs.uk/ppc.

FREE LATERAL FLOW DEVICE TESTS

COVID-19 lateral flow devices are now available free of charge from participating community pharmacies for Patients who are potentially eligible for COVID-19 treatments.

This will replace the online and telephone ordering service via GOV.UK and 119, which ceases on 15th November 2023.

The surgery will be closed from 12.00 midday Saturday 23rd December until 8.30am on Wednesday 27th December, and again from 12.00 midday Saturday 30th December until 8.30am Tuesday 2nd January.

If you require medical assistance outside our opening hours, please call 111 for the out of hours service or 999 if an emergency.
