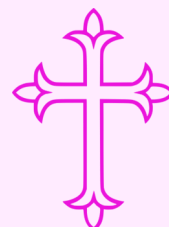

Guided tours are given on all open days and, weather permitting, the sails will be turning.

The mill now regularly grinds flour and stoneground flour will be for sale at the mill. Additional attractions include the opportunity to view the neighbouring wild flower meadow and the new Granary Building.
