Many thanks to the people who welcomed the visitors and signed their sponsorship forms.

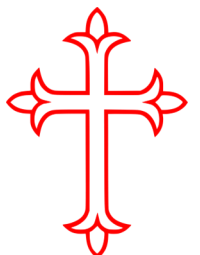


St. Mary's Church Services for November.
