

Question: Please can you explain the different options available for requesting repeat prescriptions? Are there options you would recommend for someone who is registered for online services and someone who is not?

Answer: Requesting repeats can be done online,

through Patient Access or NHS App (the latter would be the preferred option). Alternatively, patients can request by putting it in writing with name, date of birth and medication they wish to order in the letter box at the front of the surgery. With the new system, within the dispensary, we do not automatically print repeats slips anymore as we are trying to reduce paper. If patients wish for one to be printed for them, the counter staff will be happy to do so. Please remember we need at least 5 working days' notice before your Prescription will be ready to

We also offer an automatic service for patients who are on regular medication, if you are interested and would like more information please speak to a member of the dispensary team. We only accept telephone ordered orders for delivery to housebound patients only.
